BEST PRACTICES-II

TITLE OF THE PRACTICE:

Inter college (Social Emergency Response Volunteers) SERV camp in 2021-2022

The Social and Emergency Response Volunteer (SERV) Programme is designed to build community resilience through training of the target group by Master trainers, Instructors and SERV volunteer on a pan India basis. It is envisaged that, on an average, 1000 trained SERV volunteers and 2 trained SERV instructors will be available in each district of the country and at least one Master trainer will be available in each state Red Cross branch. These SERV volunteers will in turn impart health and disaster related messages apart from leading social campaigns in the community. They will be at the fore front as first community responders in case of any disaster etc. The programme will be jointly funded by National headquarters (NHQ) and the concerned State branch in the ratio of 80:20 of the fund for each activity.

Concept of SERV:

The concept of SERV is premised upon the principles of Community-Based Disaster Risk Reduction (CBDRR). It recognizes that:

1. Communities understands their problems and opportunities than anyone else,
2. Community is more interested to understand their problems than anyone else,
3. Community is the key stakeholder for development of the country, hence it has to participate in this type of programme for their own development,
4. Local communities are capable of initiating and sustaining their own community development.



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OBJECTIVES:-

To contribute to this aim, SERV volunteers will:

1. Provide immediate relief and response to the affected communities before any additional support from the government and other agencies arrives,
 2. Reduce vulnerabilities of the communities by training the communities on first-aid,
 3. Conduct vulnerability and capacity assessment of their own communities,
 4. Support any other identified social issues that contribute to the development of the communities.
5. It is envisaged that the SERVs will be trained as per prescribed modules pertaining to deliver the following:
- Act as First Responders in times of emergencies, (participate in providing effective humanitarian services to affected population to prevent and alleviate their sufferings on behalf of the IRCS)
 - Sensitize the community to make them more resilient to disasters to which the community is vulnerable.
 - Facilitate linkages between the community and the Government programmes.

THE CONTEXT:-

The Indian Red Cross Society (IRCS) is a voluntary organisation. The mission of the society is to provide relief in time of disaster and emergencies, promoting health and care of vulnerable people and communities, responding to the needs of vulnerable group, alleviating the human sufferings and helping people to live in dignity and in good physical and mental health. These are the guiding services to the thousand of local communities across the world. Their work in this area covers a wide range of activities from providing food and material assistance to the most deprived, to supporting access to employment as well as from organizing social activities to redress loneliness to running shelter for homeless people and victim of domestic violence.

The students are the future leaders not only by the qualities and skills one has but also by how these qualities and skills are used to make a difference in the world. They should not wait for any miracle but to be the source of hope and happiness in the society.

- To build their capacity in order to render the humanitarian service to most vulnerable people in the society.
- To explore the confidence of volunteers and make them guide and mentor and helping them to develop their skill and confidence that will last a life time.

Teaching session day 1 (26.10.2021):

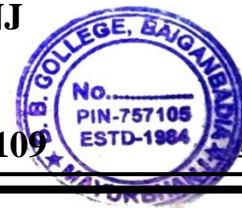

- Chest discomfort and stopping the bleeding by Pranabesh Pal at 4.30pm.



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- Red Cross pledge and end of the session at 5 pm by the request of counsellor as girl students had to cover long distance to reach their home.

Teaching session day 2 (27.10.2021):

- Bleeding, Injury, bandage taught at 10 am by Pranabesh Pal
- fracture- principles, dressing, bandage, immobilisation, transport with improvised stretcher at 11.45am by Chittaranjan Rout

- Poisoning, heat stroke, hypothermia, diabetes at 2.15pm by Chittaranjan Rout

- Practice of bleeding and fracture management by Chittaranjan Rout at 3.30
- Practice of recovery and CPR at 4.15pm
- The session ended at 5.15 pm by the request of college YRC counsellor as the girl students have to cover a long distance and shortage of daylight with oath taking and thank you clap.

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Betnoti College, Betnoti shared their experience. Then after vote of thanks the Red Cross flag was Lowering down by principal and handed over to counsellor.


PROBLEMS:
